

**Hello! Wow! The month of June flew by, and July is almost over as well! It seems like I wait all year to go to the big summer rodeos each year, and then the summer just passes so fast!**

**June was a great month for me – from placing second on my run in Reno, NV, to winning second place at High River, AB, we seemed to win enough money to climb up into the top 20 World Standings by the first part of July. With a great finish at Cody, Wy (\$3000) and a first place finish in Casper, Wy (\$3,100), I have felt very hopeful for my year to end at the National Finals Rodeo! This is so exciting to me, when just a few months ago, I was very uncertain of Shadow's future. As I write this letter from Cheyenne, Wy, we are placing 3<sup>rd</sup> in the average, and Shadow feels as strong as ever.**

**I am very happy with my horses' condition – they are very strong for this intense time of year. With the heavy hauling and hot weather, they have not dropped any weight. I have been very consistent with my feed program. I am feeding the Fastrack<sup>®</sup> Equine Microbial Pack twice a day along with the Fortifier once per day. The horses have never gone off of their feed, and Kat (my new horse) has grown lots of new muscle. I am feeding Safe Choice by Nutrena for a grain, but only ½ a can twice daily, along with alfalfa and grass mix hay. I have used the Fastrack Equine Gel twice in the last week. I gave each horse 6cc when we had to haul all night. They never showed us any fatigue. I am still very dependent on Fastrack products to help ensure my horses' consistent good health.**
